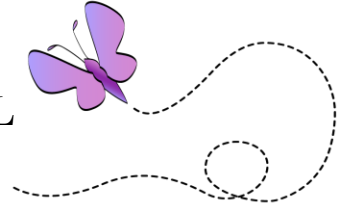




ST. TIMOTHY'S EPISCOPAL PRESCHOOL APRIL 2018

Kindergarten Pre-registration

Kindergarten pre-registration for Hamilton County schools will be this Wednesday, April 11th. (Thrasher 8:30-10 a.m. and Nolan 1-3 p.m.) Parents will need to bring their child's social security card, immunization record on Tennessee form, physical exam on Tennessee form, certified copy of birth certificate, and two current proofs of primary residency (utility bill **and** proof of lease or mortgage, etc.) Children **do not** need to be present for pre-registration.
